









Use LinkedIn to organize your networking efforts:

LinkedIn is a pretty good representation of your network. If it is not, then you need to spend some time in the "you might know" section to find everyone you ever met--not just friends.


Add a note to requests, like:

Great meeting you Friday night. I enjoyed talking about the game. I'd like to be connected here, too.

"Hello (first name), I saw you're also connected with (mutual connection). I'd love to have you in my network too.

Hi, I saw that you are a recruiter for (target company). I noticed a listing for (name of job) on your company website. Do you have time for a quick chat?

GET PHYSICAL WITH YOUR NETWORK.

During the hottest hiring season of the year, meet with someone in your network every week in person or on Zoom.

THE REAL GAME IS NETWORKING.



BELIEVE COACHES, MENTORS AND RECRUITERS THE FIRST TIME.

A GOOD OFFENSE IS A GOOD OFFENSE IN THE JOBHUNT.

Who is your 'offensive coordinator' in your jobhunt? Usually it is a recruiter. Or a coach. Or a really good mentor from somewhere like ACP or FourBlock who gives you specific advice.

You will know that you are in the right place when it is advice that you do not want to take because it sounds too unfamiliar or too forward or too aggressive.


You've got to trust recruiters and hiring managers and coaches who are giving you the right answer. I don't mean people who say they are recruiters who are offering you a job without ever seeing your resume, I'm talking about the real recruiters from your target companies. This is their job. They would not give you a hiring manager's email if that was not the way it was done.



THE MOST COMMON MISTAKE VETERANS MAKE ON THE JOB HUNT? *THEY SKIP INTERVIEW PRACTICE.*

RUNNING OVER THE QUESTIONS IS NOT PRACTICING.

- hire a career coach—there is no replacement for a live person giving you real time feedback.
- ask a mentor, spouse or teenager to listen to your interview questions and give you honest feedback.
- use an AI-powered interview coaching tool like the free tool on LinkedIn, Interviews.AI or AIApply.

GET TO THE YES

It is no wonder that your anxieties are triggered. That voice in your head is like a bad color commentator telling you your network sucks, you are qualified to do nothing, no one understands what you do, you have waited too long, you already talked to everyone you know. And, by the way, YOUR ENTIRE FAMILY IS COUNTING ON YOU TO PROVIDE FOR THEM.

No wonder you are deep into do nothingism.

When you get stuck, start again. Get to a yes on each of these questions:

- 1. Get to yes on the following question: Am I willing to get started even though I am anxious?
- 2. Get to yes on the following question: Am I willing to get started even though I don't really know what I'm doing?
- 3. Get to yes on the following question: Am I willing to get started on a task that will only take two minutes? Then string together a series of **two minute** skills.
